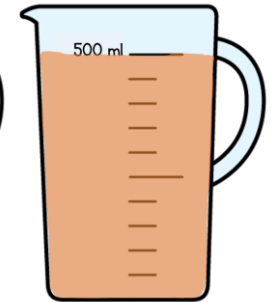
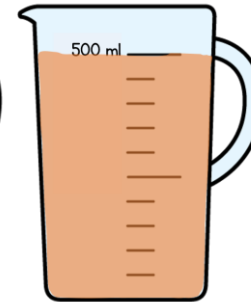
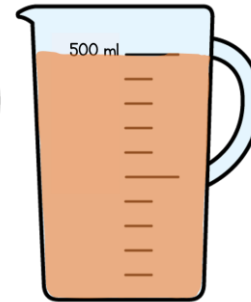
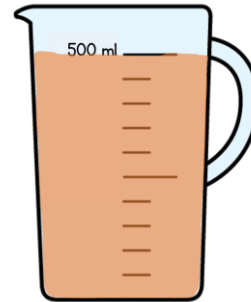
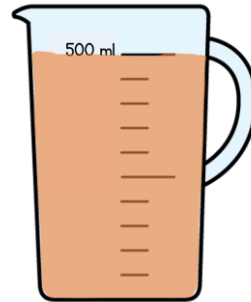
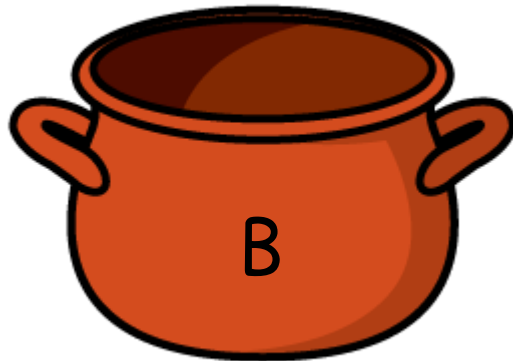
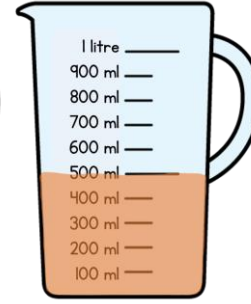
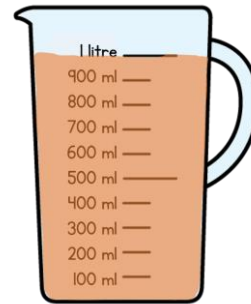
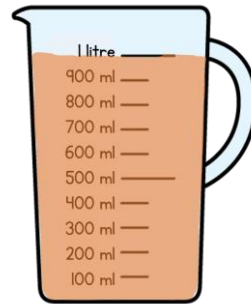


The jugs show the capacity of each pot.



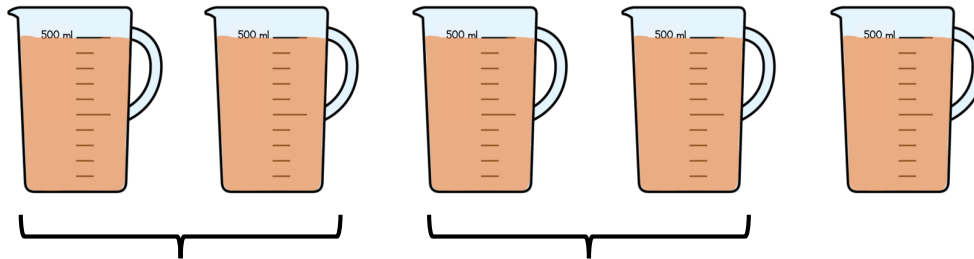
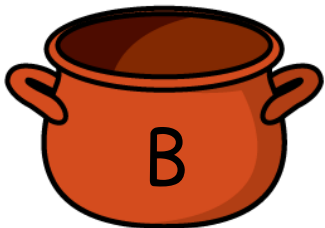
